Horse Lease

½ Lease (6 month commitment)	\$700* per month
½ Lease (30 Day commitment)	\$750* per month

½ Lease allows rider to ride 2 times per week for use in trail rides, stick and ball, hacking, beach rides, chukkers, group lessons, private lessons, horse shows, and other activities. 2 private lessons per month included in price. See lease for details.

*The club reserves the right to charge a minimum \$150 per month for advanced horses, higher level riders, and other purposes deemed necessary by the club.

If you are leasing a horse and want to ride more than twice on the horse in one week:

Private lesson (Weekends)	\$75
Private Lessons (Weekdays)	\$60
Stick and Ball	\$50
2 chukkers or group lessons (Weekdays)	\$60
2 chukkers or group lessons (weekends)	\$80

Entry Level ½ Lease \$480 per month

A school horse may be used twice per week for on farm rides (does not include beach rides, tournaments, horse shows, etc.) One 45 minute lesson per month included. A 30 day trial is available after which a 6 month lease is required. See lease for details.

Boarding:

Full Board \$775
(Feeding 2x per day, daily turnout, and stall cleaning. See boarding agreement for details.)

Polo Board \$700
(Full board with additional care including horse shoeing, worming, and shots included. Horse can be used up to 2x per week in the polo program. See boarding agreement for details.)

Paddock Board \$500
(Free choice hay/hay 3x per day as needed. Shelter provided. Stall, grain, and other services additional charge. See boarding agreement for details.)

Training Board \$1400 and up
(Full board with additional services including training the horse. See boarding agreement for details.)

Saturdays 11am Club Polo (Sundays at 2pm when we have exhibition matches on Saturdays)

Some goals:

Our Club Motto is Learn - Compete. We want everyone to feel comfortable riding and competing at whatever level they wish.

One of our goals is to form both competitive and recreational leagues. I also hope to have in the summer a weekday morning or Monday/Friday early afternoon practice in the future. Both of these goals involve reaching certain critical masses but we are driving in the right direction!

We also want those who want to be competitive to be able to ride a minimum of 2 times per week, and multiple horses per day, as it is important when training or learning to regularly exercise/study. In competitions you will ride multiple horses and play 4 chukkers so it is also a goal for people to either play 4 chukkers if playing club chukker or to stick and ball before or after group lessons at times to maximize your time and development.

Questions and Answer:

Q) I just started playing polo, do I still need a membership? A) Membership is required to play in club polo but not beginner or intermediate groups. Members are allowed to practice in the beginner or intermediate groups as well as with club polo.

Q) What other days and times is it possible to have polo? A) In the event the selected times fill up we have in the past had polo on Thursday nights, Friday afternoons early, Friday Nights, and on occasion we have had weekly groups that would meet late morning during the week. These groups are subject to player interest.

Q) When can we come stick and ball and ride or ride on our own? When signing up for a lease we determine your regular days to ride. Upon your request and horse availability we can move the day at times. You can stick and ball or play on one of these days.

In addition Wednesdays and Friday nights are good times to stick and ball. Weekends and before or after practices are good times if we have available horses.

Q) I am ½ leasing a horse and want to ride a 3rd time and stick and ball this third time, what do I pay?
A) You would pay the extra stick and ball fee of \$50

Q) I am ½ leasing a horse, can I take a lesson on a different horse before I play chukkers?
A) Yes provided there is an instructor or horse available you can take a lesson before the polo match on a different horse then play your horse.

Q) I am half leasing through the Entry Level ½ lease and want to ride a 3rd time and play chukkers, what do I pay?
A) You would pay the regular chukkers price of either \$95 during the week or \$140 on the weekend.
